1. Child Support in Shared Custody: CA

The Manitoba Court of Appeal, in <u>Stewart v. Stewart</u>, 2007 MBCA 66 (CanLII) considered the proper method to calculate child support in a shared custody arrangement. The court upheld the judgment of the lower court (2006 MBQB 118).

2. Constitutional Challenge to Domestic Violence and Stalking Act

In *Baril v. Obelnicki*, 2007 MBCA 40 (CanLII), the court allowed the Attorney General's appeal and upheld the constitutional validity of *The Domestic Violence and Stalking Act*, including ss. 12(2) and 12(3) that had been struck down in the lower court. However, the court provided direction on interpreting s. 12(2), which deals with applications to set aside *ex parte* protection orders and provides that the onus is on the respondent to demonstrate on a balance of probabilities that the order should be set aside:

...the most effective remedy in these circumstances would be to read s. 12(2) in a manner consistent with *Charter* values, and that can be accomplished by restricting the burden imposed by the section to an evidentiary burden only. Thus, the respondent must demonstrate, on a balance of probabilities, that it is just or equitable that the judge set aside the order.

The respondent's cross-appeal was dismissed.

3. Divorce Act Amendment

An amendment to <u>s.17 of the *Divorce Act*</u> came into effect on May 31, 2007. The amendment, found in <u>S.C. 2007, c.14</u> adds s. 17(5.1) to the Act as follows:

(5.1) For the purposes of subsection (5), a former spouse's terminal illness or critical condition shall be considered a change of circumstances of the child of the marriage, and the court shall make a variation order in respect of access that is in the best interests of the child.
