# 1. Mandatory electronic land registration coming to Kenora

Effective Thursday, February 23, 2006, most land registrations for the Kenora Land Registry Office must be submitted electronically. Paper documents will no longer be accepted for the majority of registrations. In *Todosichuk v Daviduik*, the Manitoba Court of Appeal reviewed and restated the general principles of the fiduciary duties of a committee and the remedies available for a breach of those duties. Read the decision on CANLII at:
