Land titles fees will be revised effective August 21, 2006. A <u>Notice</u> from the Registrar General is posted on The Property Registry website. The new <u>fee schedule</u> is available as a MS Excel document.

LTO Requires Purchaser Declaration on Condo Transfer

Effective September 1, 2006, the Land Titles Office will accept a transfer of land for a condominium unit only if filed with a statutory declaration from the purchaser regarding financial statements and a cooling-off period. See the <u>May 29, 2006 Notice</u> from the Registrar General for more details, including a blank <u>Schedule</u> form in both <u>Word</u> and <u>PDF</u> formats.
